Why Prayer Partners?

"We Know That Prayer Changes Things "

What is the importance of having prayer partners?

It is good to know that we have someone to intercede and lift us up in prayers in our haste to prepare for the Mission and whilst on the Mission

Things we ask of our Prayer Partner(s):

- ❖ Pray daily for the Team Member (and the Team).
- ❖ Preparation for Trip – General Prayer concerns before the trip.
- ❖ Finances – Pray for financial needs to acquire funds needed for the trip.
- ❖ Fears - Pray for Peace, stepping out of your comfort zone, cultural adjustments, etc.
- ❖ Travel - Prayers for a safe journey to and from our destination.
- ❖ Safety – Pray for safety in our daily travels and for our drivers.
- ❖ Physical – Prayers for Health concerns and for the long hours in the Mission Field.
- ❖ Relationship – Team Bonding.
- ❖ Country of Service – Belize and the people we will be serving.
- ❖ Effective Ministry on the Mission – serving the least of God's people.
- ❖ Family - pray for the safety and well-being of the families left at home.

Things we ask of every Team Member:

Pray about who you would like to have praying for you.

*(i.e. a good friend, a spouse, or a family member. **Please not another Team Member**)*

You **MUST** contact the person that you chose to be your Prayer Partner, explaining to them why you chose them, and get their approval **BEFORE** filling out the prayer partner information.

On the appropriate form, supply us with the following Information:

- ❖ **Name** (first and last)
- ❖ **Email Address** – (this is preferred, as prayer partners could possibly be out of the country)
- ❖ **Telephone Number** (please, not if it's International)
