Founded as a mission in March 1956, Holy Sacrament became an organized parish in 1979. As the church grew, so did its vision. The present Church building was dedicated in May 1985, and the older church building became the Parish Hall. Located at the crossroads of four south Florida communities, we are easily accessible to residents of Pembroke Pines, Hollywood, Davie, Cooper City and beyond. So although we are close to both Miami and Ft. Lauderdale, we are definitely not a “big city” urban church.
